Dear Parent/ Carer,

As you are aware, your child has been able to access Mathletics at home for the past few months and as a school we are delighted with the uptake by the children. Mathletics will be available for children to use throughout the summer and next academic year. Over the summer, you will notice a few things happening and I wanted to let you know about them.

On **31<sup>st</sup> July**, Mathletics conducts its annual archiving process. This process does not delete data but files it away to provide clear result reporting for the next academic year. Following this archiving, on-screen activity results and gold bars earned for this academic year will no longer be visible to children on their home screens. This data is all still available to teachers and in the parent reports. This process also has no impact on certificates earned, Live Mathletics scores and children's avatars and credits. Children can then continue to use Mathletics as they always have done.

During the week beginning **28<sup>th</sup> August**, we will be performing our school roll up. During this week, children's activities will be changed to reflect their new year group. Again this will not affect certificates earned, Live Mathletics scores and children's avatars and credits. The children will also keep the same usernames and passwords. Unfortunately, during this process Year 6 children will be removed from the service to make spaces for our new reception children. This will mean they will no longer have access to Mathletics.

Children can continue to earn certificates over the summer holidays and we would encourage them to continue to do this. Any children in Reception to Year 5 who earn **silver** or **gold** certificates over the holiday period will still receive these when they return to school in September.
