In French, we will be learning how to pronounce the names of instruments.

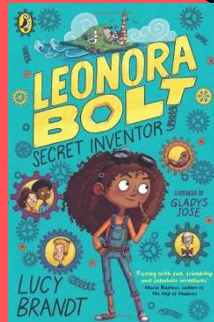
In DT we will design and make a torch.

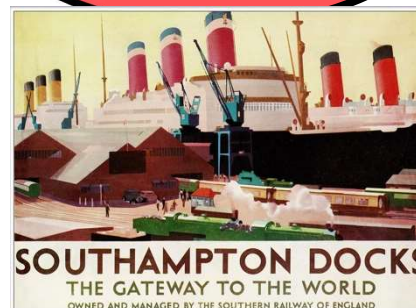
