### **PGL, Liddington Visit 2026: General Information**

As we are now just over a month away from our visit to PGL Liddington, I am writing to update you on what the children need for the trip.

#### **Kit List**

**This is not the occasion for 'best clothes' – there is the possibility of getting wet and muddy on a daily basis! Warm layers including skins will be the most appropriate clothing.**

The kit list attached (it can be found on the PGL – Adventures in the UK Booklet) is only to be used as a guide as the weather can be very unpredictable. **Please make sure all items are clearly labelled with your child's name.** You will be required to supply bedding – which must be a sleeping bag (a small pillow is optional).

**Please ensure that the bag/sleeping bag/pillow (optional) can be carried by your child as on arrival at the centre the children have to carry their own belongings to their room, large bags can make this very hard for them.**

Please **DO NOT** allow your child to bring sweets or electrical appliances e.g. Ipod, MP3, electronic games, mobile phones, tablets, kindles or any other electronic device. If any of these items are found on the visit, they will be confiscated and only returned on the Friday when we are back at school. Cameras may be brought at their own risk and we recommend a named disposable camera.

#### **Medical Form**

Please complete the medical form attached and return this to school by **Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> February**. Please note that your child's **NHS number MUST** be completed. If you do not have this information to hand, it is available by telephoning your doctor's surgery or going on the NHS number finder website.

#### **Pocket Money**

A **MAXIMUM** of £10 will be allowed per child. It would be helpful if the children could bring their pocket money as coins not notes in order that change can be given at the shop more easily. Pocket money should be brought in a clearly named wallet/purse and to be the child's responsibility.

#### **First Aid List**

We will be taking a medical kit, which will include:

Waterproof plasters      Sterilised wipes      Bandages      Children's Paracetamol

If your child is allergic to any of these items or you would prefer such things not to be used, please notify us on the back of the medical form provided.

**Medication**

All medication required by your child should be handed to Mrs Barnwell on the morning of departure - Monday 9<sup>th</sup> March, in a clearly labelled plastic bag with directions for use.

**Emergency Procedure**

Could we please ask you not to telephone your child at PGL.

In an emergency within school hours, please telephone the school. If it is out of school hours, staff can be contacted on the school mobile number 07350 535232.
