Dear Parents and Carers,

As I am sure you are very much aware, Year 3/4 have started their rehearsals for their play "Ye-Ha!" which they would like to invite you to watch.

The performances will take place in school on:

- Wednesday 25th March at 2pm
- Thursday 26th March at 4pm (children will remain in school – see below for details)

Each child will be allocated 2 tickets for any of the performances or 1 ticket for 2 different performances. There is no guarantee of a ticket at each performance, just 2 tickets across the performances. There will be no exception to this rule. All children, not in 3/4, including pre-school children must also have a ticket. For clarity this is 2 tickets in total per child.

A waiting list will be in operation but this will only be if any families decide not to take up their 2 tickets. There will be no additional tickets.

Tickets can be booked through our online booking system at <https://parents-booking.co.uk/stjohnscofe>. The booking system will open at 6pm on Friday 6th March. If you are unable to book tickets electronically, please contact the school office **after 10.30am each day only following the bookings opening**. Office staff cannot book tickets before the opening time. Please do not contact them before 10.30am as up until this point they are busy ensuring that children are registered and dinners are ordered. Bookings will close on Friday 20th March at 6pm. The office will be unable to book any tickets after the closing date.

If you wish to put your name down on the waiting list for any tickets that are not used, please email the office on adminoffice@st-johnscofe.hants.sch.uk. You will be informed of whether you have been given any tickets after the booking system has closed.

For the performance on Thursday 26th March, we would like the children to stay in school at the end of the day so we can get them ready and in their costumes for a prompt start at 4pm. If you are attending the Thursday performance, we will reunite the children back to you in the hall after the performance. If you are not attending the Thursday performance, please collect your child from the hall doors at 5pm.

As there is no charge for attendance at these performances, a collection will be held at the end in aid of the school's chosen charity.
