Stubbington Residential 2026: General Information

As we are now only a few weeks away from our visit to Stubbington, I am writing to update you on what the children will need for the trip.

Kit List

This is not the occasion for 'best clothes' – there is the possibility of getting wet and muddy on a daily basis! Warm layers will be the most appropriate clothing.

This kit list is only to be used as a guide, as the weather can be very unpredictable. However, the kit should include the following in a labelled bag or case:

T-shirts	Jeans (for evening only)
Tracksuit / Leggings	Jumpers / sweatshirts
Underwear x 3 + spares	Socks x 3 days + spares
Pyjamas / Night shirt	1 pair of outdoor shoes e.g. trainers/walking boots
Dressing gown	Plastic bag / bin liner for dirty clothes
2 towels (1 large / 1 small)	Slippers or soft shoes (for indoor use)
Wellies or walking boots (named)	Water bottle
Gloves, hat, extra sweaters	Reading book
One soft toy	Pencil case

Anorak or warm coat that is waterproof and waterproof trousers (if they have them)

PLEASE ENSURE THAT EVERYTHING IS CLEARLY LABELLED.

This kit should also include a toilet bag containing:

Brush	Comb
Toothbrush	Toothpaste
Soap	Flannel
Shampoo	Lip Balm
Shower gel	

No aerosols please!

All bedding is provided.

Please ensure that the bag can be carried by your child as on arrival at the centre the children have to carry their own bag to their room, large bags can make this very hard for them.

Please **DO NOT** allow your child to bring **sweets, musical appliances e.g. Ipad, MP3, electronic games, mobile phones, tablets, kindles or any electronic device**. If any of these items are found on the visit they will be confiscated and only returned on the Friday when we are back at school. Cameras may be brought at their own risk, we recommend a named disposable camera.

Medical Form

Please complete the medical form attached and return this to school by **Friday 5th December 2025**. Please note that your child's **NHS number MUST** be completed. If you do not have this information to hand, it is available by telephoning your doctor's surgery or going on NHS number finder website.

Pocket Money

A **MAXIMUM** of £5 will be allowed per child. It would be helpful if the children could bring their pocket money as coins - not notes; in order that change can be given at the shop more easily. Pocket money should be brought in a clearly named purse and handed to Mrs Wynn on Wednesday morning.

First Aid List

We will be taking a medical kit, which will include:

Waterproof plasters Sterilised wipes Bandages Paracetamol

If your child is allergic to any of these items or you would prefer such things not to be used, please notify us on the back of the medical form provided.

Medication

All medication required by your child should be handed to Mrs Hunter, in the original packaging, on Wednesday 21st January, in a clearly labelled plastic bag, with directions for use.

Emergency Procedure

Could we please ask you not to telephone your child at Stubbington.

In an emergency within school hours, please telephone the school. If it is out of school hours, staff can be contacted on the school mobile number 07350 535232.

We will be leaving around 9.15am on Wednesday 21st January and returning by the end of the school day on Friday 23rd January. A text will be sent out should our return be delayed.
