Dear Parents and Carers,

As I am sure you are very much aware, Year 1/2 have started their rehearsals for their play "Sir David Hattenscarf and the Wonders of the World" which they would like to invite you to watch.

The performances will take place in school on:

- Thursday 18th June at 4pm (children will remain in school – see below for details)
- Friday 19th June at 2pm

Each child will be allocated 2 tickets for any of the performances or 1 ticket for 2 different performances. There will be no exception to this rule. All children, not in 1/2, including pre-school children, must also have a ticket. For clarity this is 2 tickets in total per child.

Siblings who attend St John's school will watch the dress rehearsal on Wednesday.

A waiting list will be in operation but this will only be if any families decide not to take up their 2 tickets. There will be no additional tickets.

Tickets can be booked through our online booking system at <https://parents-booking.co.uk/stjohnscofe>. The booking system will open at 4pm on Thursday 4th June. If you are unable to book tickets electronically, please contact the school office **after 10.30am each day** as up until this point they are busy ensuring that children are registered and dinners are ordered. Office staff cannot book tickets before the opening time. Bookings will close on Monday 15th June at 6pm. The office will be unable to book any tickets after the closing date.

If you wish to put your name down on the waiting list for any tickets that are not used, please email the office on adminoffice@st-johnscofe.hants.sch.uk. You will be informed of whether you have been given any unused tickets after the booking system has closed.

For the performance on Thursday 18th June, we would like the children to stay in school at the end of the day so we can get them ready and in their costumes for a prompt start at 4pm. If you would like your child to have a small snack (not nut based products) to have before the performance, please send this in with them on the day. After the performance, children will be taken back to their classrooms to collect their belongings before being dismissed. If you are attending the Thursday performance, we will bring the children back to the hall and dismiss to you. If you are not attending the Thursday performance, please collect your child from the hall doors at 5pm.
